### Room 1:

The Studio Parking Lot

A dark, dingey parking lot surrounding an abandoned studio. A pathway is carved out by rusty television equipment. Flickering lights light your way.



#### Room 2:

Hallways of the Studio

A long, poorly lit hallway with set doors scattered on both sides. Each door is marked based on what's filming behind it. Scared, bloody humans jump out trying to convince us to leave.



#### Room 3:

Front Lawn of the Hill House



#### Room 4:

The Living Room

Barney is on the couch watching the Thanksgiving football game with some friends, but something doesn't feel right. He attempts to attacks us. There's also an overwhelming feeling that we're being watched by an ominous being.



#### Room 5:

The Kitchen

Patricia, Barney's wife, is cooking for Thanksgiving dinner. Something feels off about her as well; she attempts to attack us with cooking utensils. An ominous creature is lurking in the corner, black goo & tentacles scattered everywhere.



#### Room 6:

The Backyard

The Hill twins are playing on their backyard playground, but there are tentacles scattered everywhere. We finally realize the truths that have been hiding from us.



#### Room 7:

The Parents' Bedroom



The Twins' Bedroom


While trying to escape Patricia, we found an enemy far worse: the children. They try to play a game of hide and seek with us as they try and attack.
